Robert Dale “Sponge Bob” Lowery, 59, of Hammond, NY died at River Hospital in Alexandria Bay late Thursday evening July 2, 2015 after being involved in a motorcycle crash earlier. Born in Watertown, May 26, 1956, Bob was the son of Dale M. and Lois Jean Wagner Lowery and graduated from Hammond Central School in 1974. Mr. Lowery was employed as a Longshore Man Heavy Equipment Operator at the Ogdensburg Bridge and Port Authority. Having run the family dairy farm and Lowery’s Sand and Gravel for many years, Bob also worked as a truck driver traveling in all 50 states driving transport trucks. In the early 2000’s he earned his US Coast Guard Captain’s License and drove Tour Boats in Alexandria Bay. An avid Harley Davidson Motorcycle rider, he traveled many miles on his bike and was instrumental in organizing the Jerry Ferguson Memorial Ride, which benefits the Richard Winter Cancer Treatment Center and was involved in the Wounded Warriors Ride and many other charitable rides. A 35 year member of the Brier Hill Fire Department, he was a past president and an EMT of the organization. Surviving are a daughter and son-in-law Stefany and Vinny Carville, Morristown, a son Robert “Robbie” Lowery II, Hammond, a step-son, James Clark, Utica, four (4) grandchildren, Bryan Pratt II, Amber Clark, Kerry Clark, Garret Clark, several great grand-children, a sister Brenda Lowery Murray, Hammond.
